

# DP World London Gateway Environmental Policy

DP World London Gateway encompasses the development and operation of a deep-sea container port and logistics park.

We recognise that effective environmental management is essential to building a sustainable business, enhancing environmental performance, and preventing pollution. Operating responsibly and sustainably is fundamental to delivering long-term value for our customers, our people, our communities, and the planet.

DP World London Gateway maintains an ISO14001-certified Environmental Management System (EMS) to manage environmental impacts from construction and operations. The EMS also supports the delivery of DP World's global 'Our World, Our Future' sustainability strategy, with a particular focus on driving sustainable trade practices, fostering climate resilience, and creating shared prosperity.

In addition to aligning with our sustainability strategy, we are committed to:

- Complying with all relevant UK and international environmental legislation and other compliance obligations.
- Protecting the environment, including preventing pollution and proactively identifying and managing environmental risks and opportunities during construction and operation.
- Progressing towards Net-Zero carbon emissions, in line with DP World's Science Based Targets initiative validated targets. This includes implementing a five-year decarbonisation plan and collaborating with partners across the supply chain to drive environmental improvements.
- Reducing natural resource consumption, including minimising the use of single-use plastics wherever possible.
- Setting and reviewing environmental objectives and targets to manage significant environmental aspects of our operations and construction activities.
- Delivering our sustainability strategy's community investment programme.
- Continually improving our EMS to enhance environmental performance.

We will ensure that all management and staff are provided with the necessary resources, equipment, information, and training to understand their environmental responsibilities. Environmental considerations will be integrated into all relevant business activities.

All employees and contractors are expected to support the implementation of this policy and to carry out their work in a manner that minimises risk to themselves, others and the environment, as far as is reasonably practicable. This includes cooperating with management on all environmental matters.

The UK Chief Executive Officer holds ultimate accountability for the effective management of environmental risks and opportunities. The DP World London Gateway Senior Management Team is responsible for embedding these commitments into our business strategy and operations.

This policy and its implementation will be regularly monitored and reviewed to ensure it remains current and effective.
