





INSIDE EUROPE'S FREIGHT EXPANSION

Markus Rodatz, COO Freight Europe, on growth, innovation, and the road ahead

A freight forwarder acts as a critical intermediary in the global trade network, linking transportation companies with the businesses that require import and export services. They oversee every aspect of the transportation process, from preshipment storage to navigating customs. Freight forwarding has become a crucial component of our end-to-end logistics in Europe, experiencing significant growth in scale and capability over the past year.

In conversation with Markus Rodatz, the Chief Operating Officer of Freight in Europe, we explore how DP World's freight forwarding network is becoming a key part of the package of integrated logistics we offer, combining sustainability, technology, and regional expertise to build a network ready for the future.

A GROWTH STORY

Leading the growth of our freight forwarding business in Europe is regional Freight Chief Operating Officer Markus Rodatz. He oversees several logistics units, with freight forwarding acting as a key link. His focus has been on expanding the network and aligning services across the region to make DP World a top-tier freight forwarder globally, with Europe as the driving engine.

"At the start of 2023, we had eight offices in three countries across Europe. By the end of 2025, we will have more than 70 offices, giving us a presence in nearly 20 European countries," he says. "It was a coordinated effort that has created more than 200 new jobs in Europe."

"Now, we want to become a top freight forwarder globally. To achieve that, Europe has to be the driving engine."

BUILDING END-TO-END SOLUTIONS

Our expansion of freight forwarding strengthens DP World's ability to deliver integrated solutions.
Freight forwarding sits at the centre of the DP World toolbox, the company's model for building tailored logistics services.

These services can be offered individually or as part of a comprehensive solution, applied across our priority industry verticals.

As the freight forwarding network has grown, the service has become more advanced. DP World has invested in technology, talent and operations to make its freight forwarding offer globally competitive.

The result of this effort has already been demonstrated in action. The team recently managed the air charter of Mercedes-Benz Maybachs from Germany to Asia and handled ocean freight charters for the Formula 1. Both projects were incredibly complex and required accuracy, speed and close collaboration.

"These were not everyday tasks," said Rodatz. "They demanded precise planning and close coordination across teams. And we delivered."

A NETWORK FOR THE FUTURE

The network has also been designed with the future in mind, incorporating sustainability and next-generation technology from the outset.

For example, the Morocco Liner Service, which DP World is currently building, shifts freight from road to sea for journeys from Morocco to the UK and other parts of Europe, reflecting DP World's ability to create customised solutions that prioritise sustainability. Combined with our other fleet electrification initiatives and the use of multiple transport modes, DP World's freight forwarding operations can help customers transition to more sustainable logistics solutions.

In terms of technology, DP World's in-house-developed tech stack aims to become a market differentiator, integrating AI and automation to improve reliability and help us scale across our business.


RESILIENCE AND CONNECTIVITY

Rodatz also emphasises the importance of connectivity to DP World's ports and inland terminals. "That access means we can respond more quickly when challenges arise. It makes our network more resilient and puts our customers in control."

"When the opportunity presented itself to apply for the Branch Manager position and help establish DP World Logistics in Czechia, I applied the same day, with no hesitation. That was a year ago, and I've now been in that role for eight months," Robert shared. "We're a team of nine, primarily with air and ocean freight expertise. The early months were focused on building the operational foundation – no small feat in the world of international forwarding. With our IATA licence now secured, we're well-positioned to grow our market presence."

The Prague branch is also actively building synergies across the cluster. "We've already identified shared target clients with our new colleagues at UNICO in Slovakia," Robert added. "And once legal steps are completed, we'll also begin collaboration with EAS International in Brno. I thrive on the mix of organic growth and M&A integration, and I'm genuinely excited about what lies ahead."

In Spain, we welcomed our fourth team member—and notably, the first woman—to join the growing freight forwarding operation. With nearly 25 years of experience in the industry, including a leadership role as Ocean Freight Operations Manager, she brings a wealth of expertise in managing complex logistics and leading high-performing teams.

"Since joining, I have had an active role and have contributed to the company's readiness for the business 'go-live', not only from a business perspective, but also from a people, facility, and systems perspective. We have now established an Ocean Freight Operations team, which continues to expand.

In just under 18 months, we have established relationships with more than 150 new customers, achieving a customer-retention rate of more than 95% – a testament to our commitment to quality service and high customer satisfaction."

Among the early milestones was the execution of three charter vessels for Formula 1, including the very first shipment for DP World Freight Forwarding in Spain: a charter from Bahrain to Shanghai carrying IMO cargo. A complex and high-stakes operation, it set the tone for the team's capabilities and ambition. "I am genuinely excited about the future of DP World. I strongly believe in our potential, and I look forward to the great challenges ahead."

NEWS FROM EASTERN EUROPE

A FORCE FOR PROGRESS

As Executive Vice President of East Europe, I have the privilege of leading a dynamic region that is uniquely positioned at the crossroads of major global trade routes – between Asia, Europe and the Middle East. Since our first investment in the region back in 2004, we have seen an opportunity to modernise supply chains here, reduce friction in logistics and bring our global expertise to help improve trade facilitation. We now have a presence from the Adriatic to the Black Sea and across the industrial heartlands of Eastern Europe – 3,000 employees in total across 15 countries, including four deepsea terminals, two inland terminals and 12 logistics hubs.

At DP World, we see logistics as a force for progress. In East Europe, this means investing in digitalisation, intermodality and resilient infrastructure – while always putting our customers' needs and sustainability at the centre of our strategy. For example, we are in the middle of a €130 million investment programme in Romania, which has recently included the launch of a new intermodal terminal in Aiud and a freight forwarding office in Bucharest – the Operational Control Tower for DP World's integrated, end-to-end logistics service across Europe.

This expanding logistics offer has led to a series of major new business wins with customers from multiple industry sectors, including automotive (e.g. BMW, Sampa Automotive and Adient) and consumer goods (e.g. BSH, Europe's largest home appliance manufacturer). In Türkiye, our six freight forwarding hubs are strategically placed near key manufacturing clusters. our logistics team has also just won three awards from Turkish Cargo.

This is an exciting time for our region. With our strong footprint and new growth corridors opening up as European trade and logistics continue to reorientate towards the East, the region is becoming an ever more pivotal gateway for global commerce. I look forward to working with our partners, customers, and communities to shape a more connected and competitive future.

CONNECTING CONTINENTS WITH PRECISION CHEMICAL **HANDLING**

TÜRKIYE

NEW BUSINESS

Our Logistics division in Türkiye directs trade with a special operation. For the first time, chemical raw materials from our operations in Houston (USA) are delivered to Türkiye. All processes—unloading, handling, storage, recirculation—are managed by expert teams. Due to its structure, the material risks degradation if static too long, so recirculation is applied. Used tanks are cleaned, certified, and sent back for reuse. This complex process reflects DP World's precision and global logistics expertise and is a shining example of successful cooperation between DP World businesses.

2 MINUTES

We've unveiled a drive-through scanner at its RO-RO terminal in Constanta, Romania – the first of its kind in the region. This innovation cuts truck inspection times from 5-7 hours to just 2 minutes, boosting trade speed and security. Operational from March 2025, the scanner uses x-ray tech to verify goods without unloading. It supports EU safety standards and reduces delays. Part of DP World's €130M Romania investment, this move strengthens Romania's role as a vital logistics hub connecting Europe and the Black Sea.



i28: ENHANCING OUR MEDTECH VERTICAL – OPENING A MEDICAL WAREHOUSE IN GIESSEN

Supporting one of i28's four strategy-execution drivers, expanding industry verticals and geographies, DP World Europe Commercial was delighted to announce the signing, in 2025, of a long-term lease agreement for a 27,000 m² state-of-the-art medical warehouse strategically located in the Frankfurt Healthcare Logistics Hotspot of Giessen, Germany.

DP World has seen growth each year in healthcare logistics, connecting countries worldwide, investing in research, and supporting stronger healthcare systems. DP World Europe has nearly 40 Good Distribution Practice (GDP)-certified storage sites across 17 countries worldwide. We also have expertise in managing transport in all temperature ranges from +25°C to -190°C, which is essential for pharmaceutical products.

Our end-to-end capabilities in healthcare logistics will include transport and installation, reverse transport, repair and service parts, market access, and trade finance, as well as fulfilment and value-added services.



This investment reflects our commitment to delivering scalable, connected, and sustainable pan-European transport solutions designed to meet the demands of today and the challenges of tomorrow.




DP WORLD ACQUIRES REMAINING SHARES OF SWISSTERMINAL AG

SWITZERLAND

As part of our European i28 strategy, and aligned with our global vision to build the most comprehensive supply-chain-solutions business in the industry, DP World finalised the acquisition of the remaining shares of Swissterminal AG in March 2025.

Swissterminal currently operates one of the largest integrated container-terminal, port, and inland service networks in Europe, with terminals in Switzerland and France, including locations in Basel, Frenkendorf, and Ottmarsheim, and its own rail products connecting DP World Terminals in Antwerp and Rotterdam.

DP World has been a shareholder in Swissterminal AG since 2020, and this full ownership strengthens our ability to provide greater value for our customers.



Earlier this year, Baroness Poppy Gustafsson, UK Minister of State for Investment, visited London Gateway to mark the start of our £1 billion expansion. The project includes two new all-electric berths and a second rail terminal, set to make the port the largest container hub in the UK.

She toured the site with Group Chairman Sultan Ahmed Bin Sulayem and met with members of the leadership team to see the scale of the development firsthand.

The expansion will create over 1,000 construction jobs and 400 permanent roles, while supporting UK trade resilience and decarbonisation.

Construction began in May 2025, following the announcement made at the UK government's International Investment Summit. With this new phase underway, we continue to invest in world-class infrastructure that brings long-term benefits to the economy, environment, and global supply chains.

FAST-TRACK F1 LOGISTICS: DP WORLD DELIVERS SPEED AND PRECISION

SPAIN

To meet the high-stakes demands of Formula 1, DP World Logistics Spain delivered a time-critical solution for RPM Event Ltd, ensuring seamless equipment transport to the Monaco Grand Prix. With traditional shipping routes facing delays, we have engineered agile alternatives utilising our global infrastructure, including road, customs, shipping, terminals, coordination, and multipurpose charter vessels, across four continents. For the Melbourne (Australia) to Miami (USA) leg, we bypassed Panama Canal congestion via San Diego (USA), followed by a 4,300 km truck journey, which reduced transit time from 50 days to 23 days. From Jeddah (Saudi Arabia) to Fos-sur-Mer (France), we avoided Red Sea disruptions, completing the route in just nine days instead of the usual 45. This operation reflects our commitment to resilient, customer-focused logistics, powered by global teamwork and deep expertise, offering end-to-end service with a single point of contact for maximum customer ease.
